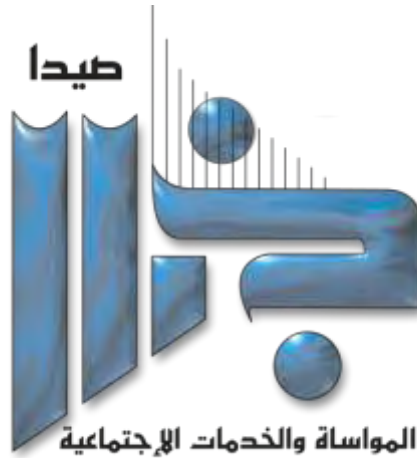

It provides attention and care to babies and children from the age of one month to the age of four years.



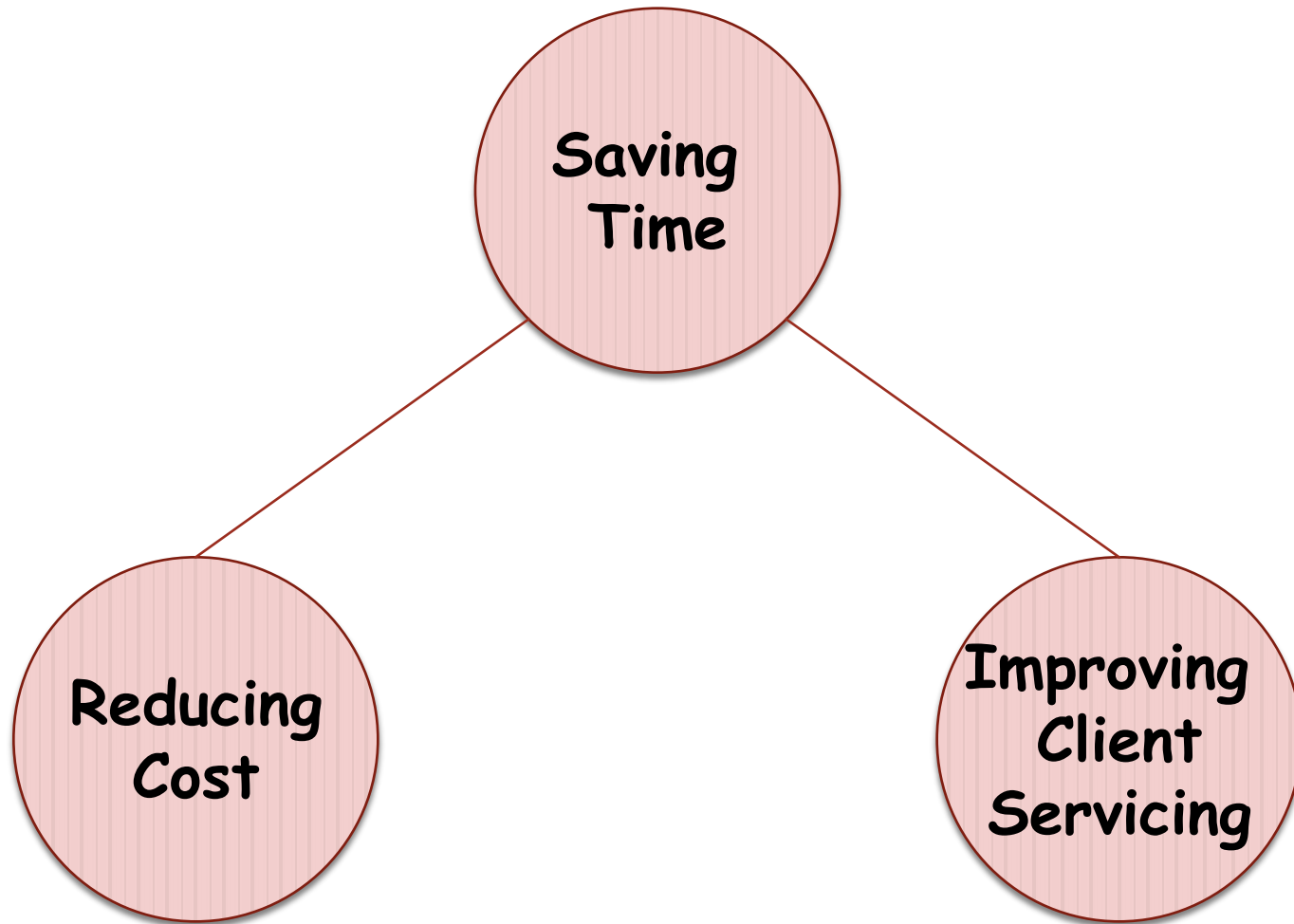
Al Moasat Beauty Center
